

Meet and Greet of Yvette Herrell and Ted Cruz on 10/3/22

On 10/3/22, Bros Ryan Gott, Nicholas Wurth and myself went to a fundraiser Meet and Greet for Yvette Herrell in Las Cruces, NM. Ted Cruz was there as a guest speaker on her behalf. Ted is currently on a bus tour called Truth and Courage Pac tour where he is visiting 17 states in one month with objective to Train, Equip, and RALLY conservative activists across the country to ensure that conservatives win their races this November.

When we first got to the restaurant (The Double Eagle) we met our New Mexico House Representative Rebecca Dow. It was first for all of us. Br. Richard has met her once. When I introduced myself and said that we go to Richard Ibranyi's church she was very nice and said thank you so much for your support.
