Gross Immorality

Fallen-Away Catholics Cursed by Almighty God!

"As they liked not to have God in their knowledge, God delivered them up to a reprobate sense." Romans 1:28

"Beware of false prophets who come to you in the clothing of sheep, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. By their fruits you shall know them... Every good tree bringeth forth good fruit, and the evil tree bringeth forth evil fruit." (Matthew 7:15)

Wake up, fallen-away Catholics of the apostate Vatican II Church! Massive sins of immorality (evil fruits) are being committed by bishops, priests, and laymen because worse sins have been previously committed that have led them to this wretched condition. As abominable and damnable as the bishops' and priests' sins of child molestation and rampant homosexuality are, much worse sins have previously been committed. You, too, are guilty of these worse sins. These worse sins have led to gross sins of immorality: abortion, contraception, divorce, physical fornication, feminist women and effeminate men, alcohol and drug addiction, gluttony, lying, cheating, and stealing. Obstinate and unrepentant sins of immorality are well-deserved punishments God has allowed to come to pass because of these worse sins. God has turned His once chosen people over to Satan to be mightily buffeted. What then are these worse sins that led to this punishment from God? I will first pose this question: Which sins are worse, sins of physical fornication or spiritual fornication? - Sins of spiritual fornication, because they are committed directly against God Himself. These are sins against the First Commandment and are the worst sins men can commit. The apostate hierarchy of the Vatican II Church, especially the apostate antipopes, have committed many of these worst sins. They and you, either explicitly by deed or implicitly by silence, boldly and confidently commit many sins against the First Commandment of Almighty God, time and time again. As high as the heavens are above the earth is how much greater sins against the faith are than those against morals. The original sin was not a sin of immorality; it was a sin against faith in God that led to sins of immorality after the fall. St. Paul tells us that when God's chosen turn their back on Him by denying the faith, gross immorality prevails. This is known as the...

Romans One Curse

"Because that, when they knew God, they have not glorified him as God or given thanks: but became vain in their thoughts. And their foolish heart was darkened. For, professing themselves to be wise, they became fools... Wherefore, God gave them up to the desires of their heart, unto uncleanness: to dishonour their own bodies among themselves. Who changed the truth of God into a lie and worshipped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. For this cause, God delivered them up to shameful affections. For their women have changed the natural use into that use which is against nature. And, in like manner, the men also, leaving the natural use of the women, have burned in their lusts, one towards another: men with men, working that which is filthy and receiving in themselves the recompense which was due to their error. And as they liked not to have God in their knowledge, God delivered them up to a reprobate sense to do those things which are not convenient. Being filled with all iniquity, malice, fornication, avarice, wickedness: full of envy, murder, contention, deceit, malignity, whisperers, detractors, hateful to God, contumelious, proud, haughty, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, foolish, dissolute: without affection, without fidelity, without mercy. Who, having known the justice of God, did not understand that they who do such things are worthy of death: and not only they that do them, but they also that consent to them that do them." (Romans 1:21-32)

Sins of spiritual fornication (sins against the faith) lead to massive obstinate and unrepented sins of physical fornication (immorality) especially when committed by so-called Catholics who profess to be God's chosen. Fallen-away Catholics are afflicted seven times more than pagans. Better not to have known God than, after having known Him, to turn your back to Him: "For if, flying from the pollutions of the world, through the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they be again entangled in them and overcome: their latter state is become unto them worse than the former. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of justice than, after they have known it, to turn back from that holy commandment which was delivered to them." (2Pt. 2:20-21) "And when an unclean spirit is gone out of a man he walketh through dry places seeking rest, and findeth none. Then he saith: I will return into my house from whence I came out. And coming he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished. Then he goeth, and taketh with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is made worse than the first. So shall it be also to this wicked generation." (Mt. 12:43-45)

St. Paul instructs Catholics to cast out brethren whose sins are of a very serious nature so they do not corrupt others: "It is absolutely heard that there is fornication among you and such fornication as the like is not among the heathens... And you are puffed up and have not rather mourned that he might be taken away from among you that hath done this thing. I indeed, absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged, as though I were present, him that hath so done... deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. Your glorying is not good. Know you not that a little leaven corrupteth the whole lump? ...But now I have written to you, not to keep company, if any man that is named a brother be a fornicator or covetous or a server of idols or a railer or a drunkard or an extortioner: with such a one, not so much as to eat. ...Put away the evil one from among yourselves." (1Cor. 5:1-13)

When faith is lost, there is no remedy for sin. "For if we sin willfully after having the knowledge of the truth, there is now left no sacrifice for sins." (Heb. 10:26) "Outside the Church there is no salvation nor remission of sins." (Pope Boniface VIII, Bull Unam Sanctum) Among fallen-away Catholics the cancer of immorality spreads like wildfire. Oh, how great does the fire spread when the shepherds lose the faith! Are the laymen innocent? No! This is a well-deserved punishment for their apostasy also. Fallen-away Catholics have gotten what they deserve and what they want—liberal, religiously indifferent, and non-judgmental shepherds. The apostate laymen cry out when they get bitten by a serpent (the apostate antipopes and their bishops and priests) and then put their hand back into the serpent's den (Vatican II Church) and get bitten again-and this occurs in an endless cycle. Does God hear your cry? No! not as long as you are bad-willed and keep putting your hand back into the serpent's den: "You have despised all my counsel and have neglected my reprehensions. I also will laugh in your destruction, and will mock when that shall come to you which you feared. When sudden calamity shall fall on you, and destruction, as a tempest, shall be at hand: when tribulation and distress shall come upon you: Then shall they call upon me, and I will not hear: they shall rise in the morning, and shall not find me: Because they have hated instruction, and received not the fear of the Lord, nor consented to my counsel, but despised all my reproof. Therefore they shall eat the fruit of their own way, and shall be filled with their own devices." (Prv. 1:25-31)

God will not help you until you resolve to learn the Catholic faith. "Attend unto reading, to exhortation and to doctrine. ... Take heed to thyself and to doctrine: be earnest in them. For in doing this thou shalt both save thyself and them that hear thee." (1Tim. 4:13,16) You are already reaping the evil consequences of your lack of true wisdom (possession of the Catholic faith). "He who refuseth to learn, shall fall into evils." (Prv. 17:16)

Osee's Prophecy

"Hear the word of the Lord, ye children of Israel, for the Lord shall enter into judgment with the inhabitants of the land: for there is no truth, and there is no mercy, and there is no knowledge of God in the land. Cursing, and lying, and killing, and theft, and adultery, have overflowed, and blood hath touched blood. ... My people have been silent because they had no knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will reject thee, that thou shalt not do the office of priesthood to me: and thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I also will forget thy children. According to the multitude of them, so have they sinned against me: I will change their glory into shame. They shall eat the sins of my people, and shall lift up their souls to their iniquity. And there shall be like people like priest; and I will visit their ways upon them, and I will repay them their devices. And they shall eat and shall not be filled: they have committed fornication, and have not ceased: because they have forsaken the Lord in not observing his law. ... for the spirit of fornication hath deceived them, and they have committed fornication against their God. ... I will not visit upon your daughters, when they shall commit fornication, and upon your spouses when they shall commit adultery: because themselves conversed with harlots, and offered sacrifice with the effeminate, and the people that doth not understand shall be beaten." (Osee 4:1-15) "Hear ye this, O priests, and hearken, O ye house of Israel, and give ear, O house of the king: for there is a judgment against you, because you have been a snare to them whom you should have watched over and a net spread upon Thabor. And you have turned aside victims into the depth... Israel is defiled. They will not set their thoughts to return to their God: for the spirit of fornication is in the midst of them, and they have not known the Lord. And the pride of Israel shall answer in his face: and Israel, and Ephraim shall fall in their iniquity, Juda also shall fall with them. With their flocks and with their herds, they shall go to seek the Lord, and shall not find him: he is withdrawn from them. They have transgressed against the Lord: for they have begotten children that are strangers: now shall a month devour them with their portions." (Osee 5: 1-7)

The holy Catholic Church is the good tree that brings forth good fruit. The Vatican II Church is a rotten-to-the-core evil tree that brings forth an abundance of evil fruit: idolatry, blasphemy, apostasy, heresy, sacrilege, and massive immorality.
