Catholics Must Not War against Russia

I also will 100% move to America if I can (In fact I WANT TO) as this RJMI document states it is encouraged, and a good thing to live with them

The only area that I would provide pushback to what he says is on secular topics where Richard himself has said on a handful of occasions he is open to being corrected.

RJMI: "If a Catholic brother thinks I am wrong even though I believe I am right, then he must act accordingly."

His position on Russia is one of them where I do not agree & in good conscience I cannot subscribe to his position.

The point/question I am getting at is, will my opposition to Russia prevent me from joining Mary's Little Remnant?

RJMI Reply:

You would not have to fight for Russia but just not fight against Russia. Here are my reasons. If you believe in all things on my site regarding the Catholic Faith, why would you let Russia get in your way and usurp all of that? I believe that you might agree that if there were a true and good pope during World War II, then he would have commanded Catholics to either fight on the side of the Axis nations or, at least, not fight against them, as the Axis nations were a way lesser evil than the Allied nations. Why do you think the USA, Canada, England, and the Western European nations so vehemently oppose Russia? Does that not tell you that Russia must be doing something right to get all these extreme lefty liberal nations to oppose it.¹

Russia is like Germany in the days of World War II, a way lesser evil than many other nations. No good Catholic would say that he prefers the USA or Canada or a Western European nation (all of which support full blown lefty liberal policies and enforces them on others) over Russia. And even though Russia is not as hard against the apostate Jews as I would wish, it is hard enough. In many of its programs on RT, it exposes the crimes of Israel and supports the Palestinians. And at times, it even refers to Israel as an apartheid state. Hungary is another nation that is a way lesser evil.

And even if Russia were as evil as the nations of the West and God has seen fit to punish the West by allowing Russia and China to conquer it, then who are we to question God's will? Most times God uses evildoers to punish evildoers.

In the days the holy Prophet Jeremias, Jerusalem and the Jews were so evil that God ordained that he would punish them by sending the pagan Babylonians to conquer and subjugate them. The holy Prophet Jeremias' job was to condemn the Jews, tell them of their upcoming subjugation, and to submit to the yoke of the King of Babylon as a punishment for their sins; and that if they did these things, their subjugation would not be as hard. What do you think was the response from the evil Jews? They accused Jeremias of being a false prophet and a traitor to their nation. Jeremias said that no nation is above God to think it can be obstinately evil and escape punishment from God. The Prophet Amos puts it this way: "Behold the eyes of the Lord God are upon the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from the face of the earth." (Amos 9:8) And Jeremias said that when God commands something it is treason not to obey. And thus it was treason against God for Jerusalem and the Jews to *not* submit to the yoke of the pagan King of Babylon:

"For among my people are found wicked men... They are grown gross and fat: and have most wickedly transgressed my words... Shall I not visit for these things, saith the Lord? or shall not my soul take revenge on such..." (Jer. 5:26, 28-29) "For I have set my face against this city for evil, and not for good, saith the Lord; it shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire..." (Jer. 21:10)
