Some of the evidence against the apostate antipopes has been deleted because it is contained more thoroughly in RJMI book *Non-Catholics Cannot Hold Offices in the Catholic Church*.

- One addition is a section titled: "**When Catholics Must Believe There Were No Popes since Innocent II or Catholic Theologians since 1250.**" This addition is so important that I will include it below:

Under pain of heresy and idolatry, a Catholic must believe there were no popes since Innocent II in 1130 and no Catholic theologians since 1250 once he sees the evidence against them and once he knows the deeper dogma that non-

Catholics cannot hold offices in the Catholic Church.

The reasons why a Catholic must believe there were no popes since Innocent II in 1130 and Catholic theologians since 1250 once he sees the evidence are based upon two basic dogmas and one deeper dogma (that non-Catholics cannot hold offices in the Catholic Church). They are the same reasons why a Catholic must condemn the Vatican II antipopes, anti-cardinals, and bishops once he sees the evidence against them. Here are the reasons:

8. It is a basic dogma that a Catholic must condemn heresy as heresy and idolatry as idolatry or he is guilty of the heresy or idolatry he does not condemn and thus becomes a heretic or idolater and is no longer Catholic. And he is guilty of mortal sins of omission. Hence once he sees the evidence against the antipopes since Innocent II in 1130 and Catholic theologians since 1250, he must condemn their heresies and idolatries. If he does not, then he is a heretic and idolater for not condemning heresy as heresy and idolatry as idolatry. And he is guilty of mortal sins of omission. It is the same thing a Catholic must do regarding the Vatican II clerics and theologians.
9. It is a basic dogma that a Catholic must denounce heretics as heretics and idolaters as idolaters or he is guilty of the heresy or idolatry of the heretics or idolaters he does not denounce. And he is guilty of mortal sins of omission. Hence once a Catholic sees the evidence against the antipopes since Innocent II in 1130 and Catholic theologians since 1250, he must denounce them as heretics and idolaters. If he does not, then he is a heretic and idolater. And he is guilty of mortal sins of omission. It is the same thing a Catholic must do regarding the Vatican II clerics and theologians.
10. It is a deeper dogma that non-Catholics cannot hold offices in the Catholic Church. Hence a Catholic who knows this deeper dogma must in the very least presume that all so-called officeholders who he knows are heretics or idolaters do not hold offices. If he knows that they are formal heretics, then it is certain they do not hold the offices. If there is a possibility that they may be material heretics, then the Catholic must still treat them as formal heretics and presume they do not hold the offices. There is no excuse for acts of idolatry and hence all idolaters are guilty of mortal sins against the faith with no excuse. It is the same thing a Catholic must do regarding the Vatican II clerics and theologians.

For example, when apostate Antipope Eugene IV put up the Filarete Doors on St. Peter's Basilica on 6/26/1445, he was guilty of idolatry for desecrating the Basilica with images against the faith (images of pagan gods, goddesses, and religions) and images against morals. He was also guilty of the heresy and idolatry of humanism and guilty of the conciliarist heresy. (See RJMI book *Non-Catholics Cannot Hold Offices in the Catholic Church: Apostate Antipope*

Eugene IV.) And all of the successive apostate antipopes promoted and added to the desecration of Catholic places. (See RJMI book *The Desecration of Catholic Places*.) And many of the apostate antipopes, such as Sixtus IV, Julius II, Leo X, and Paul III, practiced astrology. (See RJMI book *The Great Apostasy: Astrology*.) Once a Catholic sees the evidence against these apostate antipopes, he must do the following:

11. Condemn their acts of idolatry or heresy as idolatry or heresy.
12. Denounce them as idolaters or heretics.
13. Denounce them as non-officeholders, as apostate antipopes.

If the so-called Catholic does not do either of the first two things, then he is a heretic or idolater himself and commits mortal sins of omission. And if he does not do the third thing and knows or should know the deeper dogma that non-Catholics cannot hold offices in the Catholic Church, then he is a heretic and commits mortal sins of omission. (See RJMI book *Sins of Omission*.) Any so-called Catholic who avoids the evidence so that he does not have to make these condemnations and denunciations is guilty of affected ignorance and thus is a heretic or idolater himself and also guilty of mortal sins of omission. And he would also be a hypocrite and double-tongued, double-faced, and double-hearted if he denounces the Vatican II apostate antipopes but not all of the *pre-Vatican II* apostate antipopes once he sees the evidence. He would also undermine his own position regarding the Vatican II apostate antipopes. To be less dishonest, he would have to believe that all of them are apostate antipopes or that none of them are apostate antipopes and thus are popes.

“Woe to them that are of a double heart and to wicked lips, and to the hands that do evil, and to the sinner that goeth on the earth two ways. (Eccus. 2:14) A heart that goeth two ways shall not have success, and the perverse of heart shall be scandalized therein. (Eccus. 3:28) Be not incredulous to the fear of the Lord: and come not to him with a double heart. Be not a hypocrite in the sight of men, and let not thy lips be a stumbling block to thee. (Eccus. 1:36-37) Winnow not with every wind, and go not into every way: for so is every sinner proved by a double tongue. (Eccus. 5:11) No hypocrite shall come before his presence. (Job 13:16)”

As you should know, Catholics are forbidden under pain of heresy to be in any kind of religious communion with non-Catholics and non-catechumens. Hence, neither I nor any other true Catholic will enter into religious communion with nominal Catholics until they acknowledge these above facts and repent, convert, and abjure. True Catholics do not put anything over God and thus above the Catholic faith – not business associates, friends, family

members, or fear of persecution:

“Do not think that I came to send peace upon earth: I came not to send peace, but the sword. For I came to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. And a man’s enemies shall be they of his own household. He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And he that taketh not up his cross and followeth me is not worthy of me.” (Mt. 10:34-38)

To be in religious communion with a person who a so-called Catholic knows is a heretic or idolater is to put that person over God and the Catholic faith. It is to love that person who is on the road to hell more than loving God, who is the only one who can put us on the road to heaven. Jesus, son of Sirach, says, “By respect of person he will destroy himself.” (Eccus. 20:24) And Jesus Christ, son of God and son of Mary, says that it is to “love the glory of men more than the glory of God.” (Jn. 12:43) And He says that they cannot believe because they “receive glory one from another, and the glory which is from God alone [they] do not seek.” (Jn. 5:44)

- Another addition is a section titled: **“On Good Things Taught by the Apostates, and a Catholic Does Not Need Their Works in Order to Be Saved.”** What follows is an excerpt from this section:

Even though the apostate or heretical antipopes, anti-Church Fathers, anti-saints, and theologians said many good things, it only takes one heretical or idolatrous act to make them heretics or idolaters. The Eastern Schismatics also teach many good and sublime things but are schismatics and hold several heresies. (See RJMI book *The Great Apostasy: Don’t Be Fooled by Evil Men Who Do Good Things.*)

More good Catholics existed before the year 1000 than after and they did not need the post-1000 AD works of the apostate or heretical antipopes, anti-saints, and theologians in order to be good Catholics. If we needed their works to promote and defend the Catholic faith, then the Catholic Church and faith did not exist until the year 1000. As a matter of fact, I believe that the greatest number of good Catholics existed in the first three hundred years of the Catholic Church and they did not need the works of the successive apostate antipopes, anti-Church Fathers, anti-saints, and theologians in order to know, defend, and promote the Catholic faith and be holy.

The councils that we *know* are valid and infallible (such as the first eight Ecumenical Councils and the local councils infallibly confirmed by popes, such as the Council of Rome in 382 and the Second Council of Orange in 529) are a

bulwark of dogmas. We also have the infallible dogmas defined by the unanimous consensus of the apostles and following true Church Fathers. These dogmas served Catholics well in the past, and they will serve us equally well now. St. Paul says to “stand fast; and hold the traditions which you have learned, whether by word or by our epistle.” (2 Thes. 2:14) And he commanded the churches “to keep the precepts of the apostles and the ancients.” (Acts 15:41)

This lecture shows how the apostate Jewish- and Freemasonic-controlled Major Media and the radical, criminal, and racist movement Black Lives Matter are inciting racism; turning black criminals, racists, and radicals into victims; and casting police officers as racists and criminals in order to incite riots and disrespect police to the point of murdering them. In the meantime, they ignore or downplay or make excuses for the real problem, which is black criminals, racists, and radicals and black-on-black crime and black-on-white crime. Hence the Black Lives Matter movement should be called Black Lies Matter or Black Criminals Matter because Law-Abiding Blacks certainly do not Matter to them; that is, blacks who are not criminals, racists, and radicals. And you never hear from them in the Major Media and Black Lives Matter. The Major Media and this movement, along with extremely liberal politicians such as President Obama and Hillary Clinton, certainly do not truly care about the law-abiding blacks in the inner cities who are being raped, robbed, drugged, mugged, and murdered by their own people, by black criminals, racists, and radicals. The end result is what the Major Media and Black Lives Matter want: lawlessness and disorder in which “evil is called good and good evil” (Isaias 5:20) in which black criminals, racists, and radicals are called good and police officers are called evil – the very police officers who are trying to bring law and order to black communities and protect law-abiding blacks and whites. This lecture also shows how the Major Media and Black Lives Matter lie, cover up, and withhold evidence in order to promote their lying, evil agenda. The very suppression of freedom of the Press that they accuse others of, they are guilty of themselves.

This very important correction adds a necessary priority that Catholics must consider when voting for candidates for office. That priority is electability. Catholics must vote for an evil candidate when all the candidates are evil. In this case, Catholics’ priority in voting for one of them is as follows: electability, religious liberty for Catholics, and evilness. Determine the electability of the candidates, which ones have a chance to be elected and which ones have no

chance at all. The candidates who have no chance to be elected are as if they were no candidates at all, such as Third Party candidates in the USA in which the system is rigged (fixed) against them so that they have no chance to be elected, especially regarding higher offices such as the presidency. They are mostly ignored by the Major Media, they are not given as much financial support as the Republican or Democratic candidates, they are not allowed to take part in major debates in many cases, they are not allowed to be listed on the voting ballot in many States, and the electoral college is fixed against them. Many times these Third Party candidates are purposely set up to draw votes away from the Republican or Democratic candidate. If the best candidate for Catholics to vote for is un-electable, then Catholics should not vote for him and thus waste their votes. Instead, they should vote for the best of the electable candidates in order to help prevent a worse electable candidate from winning. If they vote instead for the un-electable candidate, they are helping the worse electable candidate to win and to thus go on to promote greater evils. It is as if they voted for the worse electable candidate by not voting for the better electable candidate:

The Moral Obligation of Voting, by apostate Rev. Titus Cranny, 1952:
"[Anti-] Cardinal Amette, Archbishop of Paris, implies the liceity of voting for an unworthy candidate when he writes of voting for a less worthy one. 'It would be lawful to cast them,' he writes, 'for candidates who though not giving complete satisfaction to all our legitimate demands would lead us to expect from them a line of conduct useful to the country rather than to keep your votes for those whose program would indeed be more perfect but whose almost certain defeat might open the door to the enemies of religion and of the social order.' "

The current version of this article is listed as 10/2016, even though it is posted on this day. I want to keep the format of the version dates the same for all my works by only listing the month and the year. What follows are some of the additions:

- All these deceptions are for just causes and no sin is committed in telling them, and thus they are not lies but non-sinful falsehoods. However, "He that deceiveth the just in a wicked way shall fall in his own destruction." (Prv. 28:10) Hence one can deceive a just man in a non-wicked way and for a just reason.
- "She anointed her face with ointment and bound up her locks with a crown, she took a new robe to deceive him." (Judi. 16:10)
- "It is impossible for God to lie" (Heb. 6:18) because everything God does is just and because God does not sin. However, God does tell and condone non-sinful falsehoods and thus non-sinful deceptions.

- God deceives evildoers to punish them. Job says, "He [God] changeth the heart of the princes of the people of the earth and deceiveth them that they walk in vain where there is no way." (Job 12:24) God Himself can deceive a man by putting a falsehood in his heart and mouth. For example, God can deceive false prophets: "And when the prophet shall err and speak a word, I the Lord have deceived that prophet. And I will stretch forth my hand upon him and will cut him off from the midst of my people Israel." (Ez. 14:9) Or God can deceive evildoers by commanding a good angel to deceive them by putting a false prophecy in their hearts and mouths.
- And God can deceive His friends (men who are just) with non-sinful deceptions or evasions to protect them from information they should not know. Jesus deceived the apostles by telling them that He was not going up to a feast in Jerusalem, but He went up anyway.
- It is not "God cannot deceive nor be deceived" but "God cannot lie nor be deceived." It is a fact that God deceives evildoers and just men. And these deceptions are not lies but non-sinful falsehoods, non-sinful deceptions. Hence the phrase in the Catholic *Act of Faith* which is translated "God, who cannot deceive nor be deceived" should be translated "God, who cannot lie nor be deceived," just as the Fifth Commandment must not be translated "Thou shalt not kill" but "Thou shalt not murder."

My old opinion, as stated in my book *Sexual Pleasure Is Lust*, was that all sexual pleasure is intrinsically evil and therefore all sexual pleasure is lust and thus sinful if one explicitly seeks to fulfill it. Hence, according to my old opinion, even spouses must fight against sexual pleasure when they have sexual relations to have children; if they do not, and embrace instead of reject the sexual pleasure, then they commit a sin or a fault. My new opinion is that sexual pleasure is not intrinsically evil. Sexual pleasure is good and thus not lust when it is attained with the right person, for the right reason, in the right way, at the right time, and in the right place. For a long time I thought my old opinion could be wrong. What led me to change my opinion was a chapter I was working on titled “The Stoic and Epicurean Philosophies” in my book *The Hellenization of Christianity by the Anti-Church Fathers and the Scholastics*. The part about the stoics, in particular, greatly influenced my new opinion. I realized that the stoics condemn or at least abhor the material world and good passions that God has given men to enjoy. One thing I realized about the stoics is that they deny the natural law by telling men to go against the very nature God has given them, which is impossible. They tell men to do the impossible and, even worse, to not do what God has told them to do. They condemn or abhor the good things and good passions God has given men to enjoy. Hence the stoics feel guilty when they have to eat or sleep, something they cannot avoid; but the stoics do their best to avoid these things. And when they do eat or sleep, they feel guilty as if they have sinned or at least are weak and have committed a fault. As a result, they have a big dose of scruples for not being able to live up to their stoic ideal. In short, the stoics have lost common sense, call good evil, and deny the natural law and thus the nature God has given men. As you can see, my old opinion that all sexual pleasure is lust was influenced by the stoics. I, too, told spouses that they could not enjoy sexual pleasure when they perform the sexual act and thus was telling them to go against the nature God has given them and to do the impossible. As a result, I infected those who believed my old opinion with a big dose of scruples and guilt for not being able to live up to this stoic ideal. Hence I apologize to all those whom I have harmed and scandalized by my old opinion.

Louis de Montfort was an apostate because: 1) He explicitly glorified philosophy because he was a scholastic, 2) He implicitly glorified mythology by not condemning the desecration of Catholic places with images against faith and morals, and 3) He did not denounce the desecrators but remained in religious communion with them.

In many passages of *True Devotion to Mary*, Apostate Louis de Montfort idolizes the Blessed Virgin Mary by making her equal to or above God. He refers to her as the "divine Mary" and the "divine world of God." He gives her attributes that apply only to God, saying that she is "immeasurable" and that "the length of her power which she exercises even over God Himself is incomprehensible." He also says that Mary was "altogether transformed into God"; that "in Heaven and on earth, everything, even God Himself, is subject to the Blessed Virgin"; that "when Mary has struck her roots in a soul, she produces there marvels of grace, which she alone can produce." He says that the Blessed Virgin Mary can "enrich whom she wishes; to give entry to whom she wills into the narrow way of Heaven; to bring whom she wills, and in spite of all obstacles, through the narrow gate of life; and to give the throne, the sceptre and the crown of king to whom she wills... It is Mary alone who has given to the miserable children of Eve, the faithless, entry into the terrestrial paradise...she gives no entry there except to those whom it is her pleasure to make saints."

There are many other heresies in the book. For example, he says that the angels did not know who Mary was; that she hid "herself, from herself as well as from every other creature"; that she "hid herself even unto the abyss of nothingness"; and that God "took pleasure in hiding her from all human creatures, in her conception, in her birth, in her life... Even her parents did not know her, and the angels often asked one another: 'Who is that?'" He says that "the very devils in hell respect her." He insults and denigrates the past saints and flatters the saints of the Final Days by saying that the saints of the Final Days will be much greater than the past saints, "As the cedars of Lebanon outgrow the little shrubs."
