Track Tigers Push Toward State

There were 16 Tigers from the track team competing at the 3A District 3 Meet, hosted by Cobre,

April 28, seven boys and nine girls. At the conclusion of the meet, the lists for state qualifiers was competed and nine Tigers were on the list. They and several alternates will head to Albuquerque for the State Championship Meet, May 5-6, held at UNM's Track and Soccer Complex.

Coming home from District wearing gold medals were Alex Gonzales who captured the gold in a first place Discus throw. Hayli Bagwell earning gold in both the 800-Meter and 1600-Meter Run. Rodrigo Reyes who also earned gold in the men's division 800 and 1600-Meter Run. Both Reyes and Bagwell are also on the first-place teams in both men's and women's divisions for the 1600-Meter Sprint Medley Relay.

All four on each relay squad also came home wearing gold medals. Of the Tiger girls were Mahela Hernandez, Rocio Reyes and Mariah Hernandez along with Bagwell. On the Tiger boy's squad, Pedro Reyes, Ethan Kalminson and Baruc Palacios also earned gold, along with Rodrigo Reyes.

All earning gold are now the district champions for their events. Also, those are this year's Tiger State Qualifiers for track.

Tiger who competed at District set many of their own personal records for their events. Showing that our Tigers are always pushing to improve on what they have done, those Tigers included Mariah Hernandez, running the 400-Meter in 1:08.87. Tazhia Bilyeu shattered her previous best in discus by 20 feet, with a 73-foot throw, also PR'd in Shot Put, 26'1". Alma Gutierrez improved her best in the 3200-Meter with a 15:42.99 run as well as a new personal best in the 800-Meter, at 3:12.76 run. Mahela Hernandez ran to a new PR in the 100-Meter running it in 0:13.74, with Rocio Reyes setting her best in the same run at 0:14.13. Both Evelyn Hernandez and Daraly Arrandondo set their best in the 100-Meter at 16.73 and 18.32 respectively and in the 200-Meter with 37.86 and 41.78 respectively.

Setting personal bests on the boys' team included Baruc Palacios with a 5:37.14 run in the 1600-Meter. Both Ethan Kalminson and Pedro Reyes set personal records in the 100-Meter Dash, running it in 11.75 and 11.77 respectively. Tino Macombe and Jesus Rios also improved their previous best in the 100, running in 13.76 and 13.79 respectively.

With the 3A District 3 Tournament complete, Tiger Golf will send two, Logan Woods and Caleb Harland to compete at the A-3A State Championship Golf Tournament, May 8-9, at the Canyon Club at Four Hills in Albuquerque. Logan Woods, who finished fourth at District, is ranked number two statewide for 3A girls. Caleb Harland finished seventh at District, and is ranked at number nine statewide. Because of their high ranking both qualified to compete individually at state, where they will represent the Tigers and Hot Springs High.

At District, on the course at Inn of the Mountain Gods, Caleb shot a 90, with Joaquin Guaderrama up next, finishing ninth with a 94. Logan Woods shot a 97 on the course. At state, they will compete through 36 holes over two days.
